Troy Youth Assistance is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization committed to *strengthening youth and families by preventing and reducing juvenile delinquency, child neglect and child abuse through community involvement*. It is one of 26 Youth Assistance programs in Oakland County and is tri-sponsored by the Oakland County Circuit Court-Family Division, the Troy School District, and the City of Troy. The Oakland County Board of Commissioners provides major funding for a professional counselor. Volunteers work with the professional counselor to plan and sponsor local prevention programs for Troy youth and their families.

- **Casework Services** provide confidential, short-term, family-centered counseling and referral services for youth.
- **Family Education** offers youth workshops and parenting programs tailored to today's issues.
- **Camp/Skill Building** provides scholarships for activities for youth who may need financial assistance.
- **Mentors P.L.U.S.** matches adult volunteers with youth who may need a mentor.
- **Youth Involvement** sponsors activities to help youth interact positively with one another and their community.
- **Youth Recognition** honors young people at an annual event for making positive contributions to their community.
